Dear Sir or Madam,

Thank you for your letter dated 29 March 2007 with its engaging tiny print so suitable for a young person with 60/60 vision.

I note that you have not acknowledged receiving from me all the documents that I have generated in this case which I sent to you in a smashing mini-folder.

One of the documents I sent you was my Reply to Defence (document 14) and my Witness Statement (document 29) both of which you appear to have ignored. I feel that these latter documents deal adequately with your client's assertions about the alleged provision of an infra-red system. I must say the observations made about my supposed decision not to use the proffered neck-loops for the alleged infra-red system were a bit silly. I have met Mr Neiman several times over the last few years in order to discuss the alleged weapons of mass destruction....er....I mean infra-red system. The UN inspectors have failed to find it despite years of careful search. I mean no disrespect to Mr Neiman but I feel that he does not understand completely how infra-red systems work. In particular he fails to realise that no infra-red system or induction loop system can work without a microphone being used. I know this because at one meeting he seemed

surprised that my neck-loop did not work even though he admitted that the speaker was not using a microphone.

As you know, many weeks ago I asked Mr Neiman to give me the contact details for the auditory equipment provider based in Lewes and supposedly au fait with the alleged infra-red system at The Old Market. He never came back to me. So where are we now? I well understand that The Old Market is a charity and I wish it no ill-will. The problem is that they just will not either install or have working an infra-red system or induction loop system. They keep fobbing me off. I will not go away and am quite happy to attend the Case Conference and let the latter go to trial. I am equally happy to meet someone responsible to The Old Market who will discuss with me what they allege they have, with evidence and what they intent to install. It must be understood that most infra-red systems and all induction loop systems cannot be tested by a person not wearing a hearing aid or not using a simulator. The Old Market must pull its socks up once and for all. I am blind and deaf but not particularly stupid – although I may look like that.

Your client must act quickly and agree to a course of action and perhaps a Court Order by consent. I am quite happy to talk to you on the telephone but we must talk constructively.
