Dear Maria Seale

During the hearig and site visit on Wednesday ,9 February 2005 in connection with the above planning application and the proposed stopping-up of St.James's Place, we all became aware of an ugly brick pier that has been constructed in the western flint wall to apparently latch the proposed gate against.

It seemed that you recognised this masonry as not forming any part of the planning application in question nor part of any other planning application. You also seemed, like most of us, to consider the pier to be entirely inappropriate. Doubtless, you have already brought the situation to the attention of your colleauges in both the Conservation and the Enforcement teams for action to be taken to obtain early reinstatement of that beautiful flint wall.

For good order's sake, would you please confirm to me that such action has been initiated and could you also pelase indicate an expected time scale for the envisaged enforcement process and a date by which date we can all expect to see that flint wall returned to its former glory.
